

ANTI-BRIBERY AND ANTI-CORRUPTION POLICY STATEMENT

This Anti-Bribery and Anti-Corruption Policy Statement is complementary to and is to be read together with MACC Act 2009 and MACC (Amendment) 2018, TBP Whistleblower Policy and other Policies and Procedures.

Any person who commits an act of bribery, knows or fails to report and act of giving and offering of bribery is committing an offence under MACC Act 2009 and the MACC (Amendment) Act 2018. Upon conviction, the person shall be liable to a fine of imprisonment or both as stipulated in the Act.

This Anti-Bribery and Anti-Corruption Policy Statement demonstrates TBP’s commitment towards having a strong culture of high ethical practice among its Personnel and embedding Core Values in all business practices.
